This Special Issue, "Multimomics Perspective in Pharmacogenomics," welcomes original research, reviews, methods and software papers and clinically grounded case studies that advance multimomics integration frameworks (statistical learning, network/graph models and AI), biomarker discovery and functional validation. Priority themes include multi-ancestry and equity-oriented designs, longitudinal sampling, single-cell and spatial omics, reproducible pipelines and external validation and ethical-regulatory pathways for implementation. Authors are encouraged to follow FAIR principles (findable, accessible, interoperable, reusable), report harmonized metadata and batch-control strategies and use community standards for variant and phenotype representation to accelerate translation into clinically interpretable decision support and PGx-informed drug selection and dosing.
