However, manuscripts describing uncharacterized extracts with studies of common activities (e.g., antioxidant properties) will not be considered. Review articles are also welcome, but will only be of interest if there is evidence of traditional uses and/or food value while the plants/mushrooms have not extensively explored for their chemistry and bioactivity.
