# Behavioral Operations Management

### Message from the Guest Editor

I would like to invite you to send papers to our Special Issue on behavioural operations management (BOM). Behavioural operations management addresses the role of humans in operations management. We are interested in studies that apply interdisciplinary theories to shed light on new aspects of human behaviour and decision making in operational contexts. Currently, the field highly relies on a few theories related to heuristics-and-biases, bounded rationality, motivation, feedback, and learning. Similarly, in the individual differences line, which has received attention from behavioural operations researchers in the past few years, the main focus is on the rational/analytical thinking style while other aspects, such as intuitiveness and creative thinking styles, have not received equal attention in operational contexts. In this Special Issue we want to extend the knowledge in BOM by both building on the past research and adding to it with a novel perspective that can enrich the BOM literature in order to create a deeper understanding of the interaction between humans and operational contexts.
