This award provides financial support for the winners to attend an international conference in the field of *Remote Sensing* to be held in 2022, in order to hold a presentation, present a poster, or both.

2022 TRAVEL AVARDS FOR POSTDOCS AND PHD STUDENTS

Candidate Requirements:

- Postdoctoral fellows or PhD students.
- Plans to attend an international conference in 2022 (oral presentation or poster).

Required Application Documents:

- Information of the conference the applicant is planning to attend and the abstract that will be submitted.
- Curriculum Vitae and list of publications.
- Justification letter describing the focus of the research (max. 800 words).
- Letter of recommendation from the supervisor, research director, or department head, which also confirms the applicant's status as a postdoctoral fellow/ PhD student.

The winners (two awardees) will each be awarded CHF 800 and a certificate.

Please submit your applications for the *Remote Sensing* 2022 Travel Awards online by **31** January 2022. Prizes will be awarded at the end of March 2022 and announced on the *Remote Sensing* website.
