Experimental sociology has a long history. Experimental social sciences form an interdisciplinary area that connects sociological questions to social psychological underpinnings and economic conditions. Classical issues from norms to social roles and trust to morality can be intersected in studies of social action and interaction at micro and/or macro levels.
