### Message from the Guest Editor

Climate change is altering not only the ecosystems of the world, but also the social, political, and cultural systems. Industrialized societies' reliance on fossil fuels is generating dire consequences and efforts are underway to shift to alternative energy sources, different economic structures, and new cultural norms. - Is there contestation over the definition and meaning of climate justice?
