Exploring Global Environmentalism: Environmental Identity, Belief, and Pro-environmental Behaviors

Message from the Guest Editors

Enviornmentalism has narrowly focused on proenvironmental behaviors. However, there is a growing consensus that environmentalism is a multifaceted construct that should be studied holistically with integrative methodologies. Additionally, environmental psychology has been hindered by focusing largely on WEIRD populations. This Special Issue will gather diverse and novel research on environmentalism including environmental attitudes, beliefs, identity, and pro-environmental behavior. We welcome papers that meet the following points, broadly:

- Examine individual and cultural factors for prompting pro-environmental behavior;
- Investigate the relationship between environmental identity, belief and pro-environmental behavior, as well as psychological and cognitive outcomes, including well-being, mental health, and adjustment;
- Explore viewpoints and experiences of underrepresented populations to better understand cultural influences;
- Emphasize both internal and contextual factors that advocate for environmental policy and education;
- Highlight the innovations in measuring environmentalism, either via quantitative, deeper qualitative observations, or mixed-methods approaches.
