Message from the Guest Editors

This special issue aims to explore the dynamics of socio-spatial inequality and segregation in major cities across the world, as well as the social and institutional responses that can counteract them. The papers will tackle aspects such as: a) the magnitude and the evolution of residential segregation in large cities and its relationship with social inequalities; b) the differences in the living conditions in different urban areas and their social effects in ambits like housing, work, food, education, childhood and urban mobility; c) the role of community action and solidarity practices in the face of increasing social and urban vulnerability; d) the social effects of the uneven distribution of public resources across different urban areas; e) the role that urban policies can play in counteracting socio-spatial inequalities.
