Dear colleagues, Since its earliest definition by Thomas A. Hose during the 1990s, geotourism has continued to expand and develop on a global scale. Consequently, more and more information is needed on market typologies and geotourists' preferences and motivations for visiting geosites. This information can be used to establish the best marketing tools to attract visitors and reach new market segments. The concept of sustainability puts the products and local community at the core of the tourist experience, but to fully achieve sustainable geotourism, elements such as visitors' motivations for visiting geosites, their interests, and their levels of involvement and engagement need to be considered.
