Message from the Guest Editors

A stream of research in recent years has addressed sustainable entrepreneurship as a way to balance the economic, environmental, and social dimensions in new ventures creation. However, sustainability should not be treated as a binary variable, sustainability performance can arise from entrepreneurial activities and behaviors inside firms (intrapreneurship) whose primary goal is not sustainability. The literature on intrapreneurship highlights the bottom-up nature of the construct and the importance of the entrepreneurial behavior of employees to shape organizational strategic direction.

There is a research gap on how entrepreneurship inside firms can contribute to corporate sustainability. The aim of this Special Issue is to advance our understanding of the relationships between intrapreneurship and the social dimension of sustainability by either exploring how a social sustainability orientation is able to enhance intrapreneurship or analyzing intrapreneurship as a driver of sustainability. We welcome contributions dealing with systematic reviews, case studies, analytical methods etc.
