Message from the Guest Editors

Dear colleagues,

This Special Issue is aimed at gathering international perspectives as well as new approaches in the study of public perceptions of air pollution. The submitted papers are expected to cover a wide range of topics such as the relationship between subjective and objective measures of air pollution, the assessment and 'sense-making' that takes place when lay audiences receive information and advice about air pollution, spatial patterns of local risk perception, the intersection between air pollution perceptions and environmental justice, indoor air quality perception, how halo effects, place attachment, or stigmatization can influence the public perception of air quality, the role of socio-demographic characteristics and contextual factors in forming perceptions, the relation between air pollution, perceptions, and people's subjective well-being or the acceptance of policy instruments to mitigate air pollution.
