We are pleased to announce that *Symmetry* is now inviting nominations for the *Symmetry* 2022 Young Investigator Award. This prize will be given to one young investigator in recognition of their excellence in the field of theories and applications related to symmetry/asymmetry phenomena in all scientific studies. All nominations will be assessed by an Award Evaluation Committee led by the Editor-in-Chief, Prof. Dr. Sergei D. Odintsov.

The prize:

- 2000 CHF (Swiss Francs);
- Option to publish one paper free of charge in *Symmetry* after peer review before the end of 2023;
- An engraved plaque.

Eligibility and Requirements:

- Should have a Ph.D degree;
- Should be below 35 years of age by 31 December 2022;
- Should have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of theories and applications related to symmetry/asymmetry phenomena in all scientific studies;
- Candidates must be nominated by senior scientists.

List of Documents for Nomination:

- Detailed curriculum vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Birth certificate or other proof of age;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

Schedule:

- Open for nominations: 15 February 2022;
- Nomination deadline: 30 October 2022;
- Winner announcement: 15 December 2022.
