2023 YOUNG INVESTIGATOR AWARD

Dear Colleagues,

We are pleased to announce that *Toxics* is now inviting nominations for the *Toxics* 2023 Young Investigator Award. This prize will be given to one young investigator in recognition of their excellence in the field of toxics. All nominations will be assessed by an Award Evaluation Committee led by the Editor-in-Chief, Dr. Demetrio Raldúa.

The Prize:

- CHF 2000;
- The opportunity to publish one paper free of charge in *Toxics* after peer review before the end of 2024;
- An electronic certificate.

Eligibility and Requirements:

- Must have received their PhD no more than 10 years prior to 31 December 2023;
- Must have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of the field of toxics;
- Candidates must be nominated by senior scientists.

Documents Needed for Nomination:

- Detailed Curriculum Vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's research grants;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

Schedule:

- Open for nominations: 31 March 2023.
- Nomination deadline: 31 January 2024.
- Winner announcement: 31 March 2024.
