We are pleased to announce that *Tropical Medicine and Infectious Disease* (*TropicalMed*) is now inviting nominations for the *TropicalMed* 2022 Young Investigator Award. This prize will be awarded to one young investigator in recognition of their excellence in the field of tropical medicine and infectious disease. All nominations will be assessed by an evaluation committee, which will be led by the Editor-in-Chief Prof. Dr. John Frean and the Associate Editor Prof. Dr. Peter A. Leggat.

2022 YOUNG INVESTIGATOR AWARD

The prize for this award is as follows:

- CHF 1000 (Swiss Francs);
- Option to publish one paper before the end of 2023, free of charge, in *TropicalMed*, following peer review;
- A certificate.

Eligibility and requirements are as follows:

- Must have a Ph.D. degree;
- Must be below the age of 35 on 31 December 2022;
- Must have produced ground-breaking research (within the last five years) and made a significant contribution to the advancement of the knowledge of tropical medicine and infectious disease;
- Must be nominated by senior scientists.

The list of documents needed for nomination is as follows:

- Detailed Curriculum Vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Birth certificate or other proof of age;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

Schedule:

- Open for nominations: 1 January 2022.
- Nomination deadline: 31 December 2022.
- Winners announcement: 28 February 2023.
