Message from the Guest Editor

This Special Issue is dedicated to publishing original research and literature reviews on a broad range of travel medicine-related subjects. The prevention of tropical infectious disease has been the backbone of travel medicine since its inception. Research submissions at the intersection between tropical and travel medicine are strongly encouraged. There will be a focus on the unique challenges and needs of travellers with pre-existing medical illnesses and the complexities of counselling special groups of travellers and travellers embarking on specialised itineraries.

The Special Issue aims to examine the application of technology in pre-travel health care and assessment of the returned traveller. Manuscripts which explore the potential for artificial intelligence and virtual reality to transform travel medicine practice are of interest. The health needs of migrants, including asylum seekers and refugees, remain a significant focus of the travel medicine community. Submissions are invited on all aspects of migrant healthcare, including screening for imported tropical infectious diseases and non-communicable disease.
