This award provides financial support for the winner to attend an international conference in the field of veterinary sciences, including the prevention, diagnosis, and treatment of disease, disorder, and injury in animals to be held in 2023, in order to hold a presentation, present a poster, or both.

2023 TRAVEL AVARD FOR POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWS OR PHD STUDENTS

Candidate Requirements:

- Postdoctoral fellows or PhD students.
- Plans to attend an international conference in 2023 (oral presentation or poster).

Required Application Documents:

- 1. Information of the conference the applicant is planning to attend and the abstract that will be submitted.
- 2. Curriculum Vitae and list of publications.
- 3. Justification letter describing the focus of the research (max. 800 words).
- 4. Letter of recommendation from the supervisor, research director, or department head, which also confirms the applicant's status as a postdoctoral fellow/PhD student.

The winner will be awarded CHF 500 and a certificate.

Please submit your applications for the *Veterinary Sciences* 2023 Travel Award online by December 31, 2022. Prizes will be awarded at the end of February 2023 and announced on the *Veterinary Sciences* website.
