Curing and eradicating HIV require a deep insight into viral replication mechanisms. Over the past two decades, significant progress has been made in understanding the complex interaction between HIV-1 and host factors that either facilitate or inhibit viral replication. This Special Issue of *Viruses* will review the latest developments in the HIV-1 field, with a particular focus on host cell factors that participate in various steps of viral replication such as viral entry and capsid nuclear import, as well as uncoating, integration, transcription, viral packaging, and assembly.
